Much of rural Alaska still resembles conditions in the developing world. We have significant challenges ahead






- Small staff; many partners



Example: Mekoryuk

Two for One - improved harbor dredge spoils used as fill material for new bulk fuel facility instead of shipping rock long distance = less cost, quicker completion, combined logistics

 - Wind technicians trained from Gambell, Savoonga, Chevak & Hooper Bay








