FIMA and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act: Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Program

Over **\$1 billion** to support states, local communities, tribes and territories as they undertake hazard mitigation projects

FIMA and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act: Safeguarding Tomorrow Through Ongoing Risk Mitigation (STORM) Act

\$100 million for each of the next five years to establish revolving loan funds to provide hazard mitigation assistance to local governments

FIMA and the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act: National Dam Safety Program (NDSP)

\$733 million to help advance the goal of a national level dam risk assessment driven by states
