



FY24 Homeland Security Appropriations Bill Highlights and CDS Requests:

Homeland Security

Senator Murkowski secured \$150 million for the U.S. Coast Guard to acquire a Commercially Available Icebreaker to improve our nation's strategic capabilities in the Arctic and to improve maritime domain awareness while also including support for U.S. Coast Guard infrastructure. She also worked to include funding to mitigate future natural disaster events. She ensured that the bill would strengthen border security and provide resources to combatting the fentanyl crisis. Senator Murkowski's CDS requests and appropriation wins include:

- **Skagway:** \$5.101 million to the Municipality of Skagway for phase one of a rockslide mitigation project to protect Skagway's critical port economy.
- **Haines:** \$1 million to the Haines Borough for an emergency operations center.
- **Mat-Su Borough:** \$1.25 million to the Matanuska-Susitna Borough for a project that will offer a proposed protection and safety option for homeowners in critical at-risk flooding areas.
- **Seward:** \$655,000 to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for a Seward Bear Creek Service Area flood mitigation project.
- **Seward:** \$25 million to advance the Fast Response Cutter homeporting project in Seward.
- **USCG:** the bill provides 5.2% pay raise for Coast Guard military personnel.
